YOUR DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

July 9: WASHINGTON/ACCRA

Depart on an international overnight flight to Accra. Dinner and breakfast are served on board.

July 10: ACCRA

Upon arrival in Accra, we are met by our tour guide, and next board our motorcoach for transfer to our hotel. Accra is the capital of Ghana with a population of over 2.6 million people. Our visit to Accra gives us the opportunity to experience Accra's vibrancy through its traffic, its lush residential areas for the rich, and traditional buildings for the middle income and low-income people. Residents of this cosmopolitan city speak various languages. Overnight in Accra.



July 11: ACCRA

Today's tour includes visit to the W. E. B. Du Bois Centre for Pan-African Culture, the National Museum for collection of prehistoric and contemporary artifacts, the Nkrumah Park for a guided tour into the life and work of the first president of Ghana and finally the Arts Centre for shopping before returning to our hotel. Afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Accra. (B/D)

July 12: ACCRA/KUMASI

After breakfast we drive north to Kumasi, the cultural city of Ghana and home of the Asantehene, the ceremonial ruler of the Ashanti people today. Our first stop is the craft village of Bonwire, home of the famous Kente cloth, to learn about its origin and how the weavers pass it from generation to generation. Then we travel to Ntonso town where traditional Adinkra cloth is made so we can learn how to make our own patterns and how the back color of the cloth is made. Tour continues to Ahwiaa, a village known for its wood carvings, arts, crafts, the fertility doll, and famous Ashanti State (ceremonial

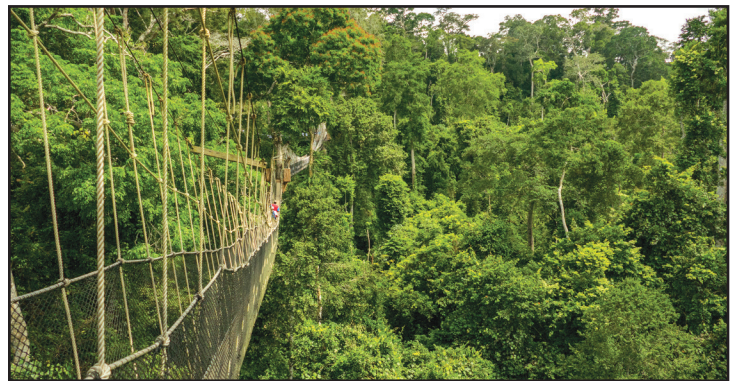
stools for the chiefs and high-ranking officials. We enjoy lunch at a local restaurant enroute to Kumasi. Upon arrival in Kumasi, we can see lots of people clad in the world famous Kente, a cloth that is the epitome of culture and pride of the Ashantes. Dinner and overnight in Kumasi. (B/L/D)

July 13: KUMASI

Today's tour allows us to experience the richness of Ashanti culture. We visit the Kumasi Centre of National Culture, the true display of richness of Ghanaian culture and heritage, and its Prempeh II Jubilee Museum. Then we drive to the Manhyia Palace, the seat of the Asantehene, the King of Ashanti Kingdom. In the afternoon we visit a cocoa farm in a local village (Golden Pot). Dinner and overnight in Kumasi. (B/D)

July 14: KUMASI/HERITAGE TOUR/ CAPE COAST

After breakfast we head south to visit the Kakum National Park and its rich flora and fauna and spectacular scenery. Enjoy a walk on one of the only four canopy walkways in the world and view the various levels of the tropical rainforest from above. Or trek on the trail and learn about the medicinal values of the various African tree species. Continue to the Central Region and the Cape Coast which is one of the most historical cities in Ghana. Then we travel to Elmina to visit the Elmina Castle (also known as the St. George of the Mine Castle), a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the first European edifice constructed in Africa by the Portuguese in 1482 and taken over in 1637 by the Dutch who retained control for 274 years. Dinner and overnight in Cape Coast. (B/D)



July 15: CAPE COAST

After breakfast we continue our tour of the Cape Coast where most of the oldest and best schools in Ghana are located. We visit the Cape Coast Castle from which

thousands of slaves were shipped to the Caribbean and the United States. The castle was the seat of British Colonial administration until 1877 when the government offices moved to the Christiansborg Castle (Osu Castle) in Accra. This historic castle was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2014 and converted into the Presidential Museum in 2017. Dinner and overnight in Cape Coast. (B/D)

July 16: CAPE COAST/ACCRA

This morning we depart Cape Coast and drive northeast through beautiful countryside to Accra. Upon arrival we visit the Makola market, the largest open-air market in the city, and the best place to

witness the hustle and bustle of the West African market. Dinner and overnight in Accra. (B/D)

July 17: ACCRA/WASHINGTON

Day at leisure to pursue your own interests. In the evening, we enjoy the farewell dinner with a culture performance at a local restaurant. Then, we transfer to the airport for your late evening flight back home arriving the next day. (B/D)

July 18: WASHINGTON

We arrive in the USA today.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Tour prices: All prices in this brochure are based on airfares, land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 30 passengers or more. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to therein as "Journeys Unlimited"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations, changes in fuel prices and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments: Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per person deposit plus applicable (optional) insurance. Receipt of your deposit shall act as your agreement to these terms and conditions. Balance is due 75 days before departure date. If final payment is received less than 75 days, a late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$50.00. If final payment is made by credit card (American Express, Visa, MasterCard), Journeys Unlimited requires a completed credit card authorization form. All payments made by check should be made payable to Journeys Unlimited.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment plus applicable taxes and optional insurance is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50.00 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services. No personal checks will be accepted with reservations received 30 days or less before departure date. Money order, bank check, certified check or credit cards (American Express, Visa, and MasterCard) will be accepted.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for US passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-US citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non US citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the USA. Journeys Unlimited assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. Journeys Unlimited will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

Final Documents and Tickets: All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within 3 weeks of departure. Documents and tickets are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

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Airline Seat Assignments and Special Services: There is no advance seat selection. Early check-in is necessary to secure seats with travel companions. Seating is solely under control of the airlines. Some airfares used may be eligible for frequent flyer mileage.

Baggage: The company is not responsible for any additional charges collected by the carriers at the airport for luggage fees. We recommend that you take along one suitcase per person with a maximum weight of 50lbs., plus one carry on with maximum dimensions of 9"X14"X22". Airlines also have their own baggage restrictions; please check with the air carrier prior to your departure. All baggage is the passenger's responsibility throughout the tour. Journeys Unlimited is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your baggage. If a bag is lost or damaged in-flight, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly.

Airline Clause: The airlines concerned will not be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time passengers are not aboard their aircraft. The passenger tickets in use by the airline, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between airline and the purchaser of these tickets and/or passenger. These tours may be sold in connection with the services of any ATC or IATA Airline.

Rooms: Prices shown in the brochure are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room or cabin. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement shown per tour. In some cases, when requested, we may be able to find an appropriate roommate for passengers who have booked as a single person. If a roommate is not available, you must pay the single room supplement. While single rooms provide privacy they are often smaller than twin bedrooms. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

Medical Conditions: While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance Journeys Unlimited is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.

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Cancellation Policy and Refunds: We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your Journeys Unlimited pilgrimage. However, should you need to cancel, your cancellation must be received in writing, via email, fax or by letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Journeys Unlimited before we can process your refund. The following cancellations fees are only for fixed departure date tours published in our brochure. Fees for custom groups and tours may be different, please contact us for details. If we cancel: We reserve the right to cancel a specific departure date or whole tour due to lack of participation or for reasons beyond our control such as natural disasters, acts of God or government restrictions. If such an unlikely event should occur, we will offer an alternate departure date or tour program. Should you decline an alternate date or should we cancel the tour outright, the limit of our liability to you will be the refund of all monies received, including any cancellation penalties, except for expenses the company incurs such as airline deposits, cancellation fees, hotels or other services. We will not be liable, however, for costs incurred by you not paid to us, such as visas and passport costs, items of a personal nature, domestic transportation either by ground or air etc. nor will we be liable for any psychological damages, traumas, stress, disappointment, personal and financial loss resulting from our change of departure date or cancellation of a tour. Refunds are not provided for services included, but not used on a trip.
